Middle and High School Enrichment Classes Available Fall Term (1st Semester) 2026/2027

Visual Arts

- **Ceramics:** Students learn both hand-building techniques and the wheel to create ceramic decor and pottery.
- **Fine Arts:** Students learn about art theory, famous artists and their styles, and a wide range of mediums. Their completed works will be displayed around the school or submitted into contests prior to being sent home.
- **Independent Art:** Students propose their own art projects they would like to create.

Sports, Games & Physical Activities

- **PE (Required):** Led by St. Sports Coaches, students do cardio, calisthenics and team games to promote health, fitness and sportsmanship.
- **Elective PE:** A class for students to get even more exercise while playing enjoyable sports.
- **HS Dance Elective:** An alternate option for High School students during their required PE slot. Students will learn and practice different styles of dance, as well as learn choreography.
- **Flag Football:** Students further develop sportsmanship, teamwork and stamina while enjoying this popular class.
- **Bowling:** An off-campus activity, students are coached to develop skills and techniques in preparation for a future competitive bowling team.
- **Futsal:** An indoor soccer activity, developing teamwork and physical skills in an enjoyable afternoon class.
- **Middle School Futsal Team:** Starting in September, practices and games are after school.
- **High School Futsal Team:** Starting in September, practices and games are after school.
- **Strength Training:** Students use their own body weight as resistance to build muscle, endurance, and flexibility.
- **Pilates:** Using Pilates mats and technique, students learn stretches and exercises to develop strength, endurance, and flexibility.

- **High School Girls Varsity Volleyball Team:** Practices, interscholastic games and tournaments are after school.

Performing Arts

- **Band Club** - Students further develop their musical skills in a variety of instruments and vocals as they work together to create performances throughout the school year.
- **High School Play:** Directed by Nick Koenig and Megan Spencer, High School students will perform *Natasha, Pierre & The Great Comet of 1812* this fall. Show dates November 6th and 7th.
- **High School Play Stage Crew:** Students learn the basics of theatrical design and production and work together to create sets, props, and other design elements for the High School Play.

Science and Technology

- **3D Engineering and Coding**—Students will learn engineering skills and design their own 3D-printed creations, as well as develop coding skills for website and game design.
- **D&D Club:** Students work together to use their creativity, critical thinking, and problem solving skills to write, manage, and accomplish original campaigns.

Living Skills

- **Sewing:** Students learn organization, crafting and sewing skills, and help to create costumes for the High School play.
- **String Arts:** Students learn the string craft of crochet or macrame and make scarves, hats and more.
- **Woodshop** - Students learn to use various hand tools, power tools, and even laser engraving to create projects of the students' interest.
- **Debate Club:** A student-led club in which members learn and practice debate skills through structured arguments, fostering their communication and public speaking skills.

Other

- **“Approved Out of School Activity”** - If desired by the family, an option to leave school early to pursue other enrichment activities that are in alignment with the student's academic requirements and personal goals, such as a club sport, an off-campus project like community service, or a part-time job. Families must complete the Outside Enrichment Approval Form prior to leaving early.
- **Study Hall:** An option for students to catch up or get ahead in studies, or additionally for doing required school projects on campus without sacrificing academic time
